BOUND BROOK, NJ – Continuing to provide support for the region's non-profit community, Alpine Business Systems named the Middle Earth as "Hero of the Month" for May 2021.

Each month an Alpine employee selects a non-profit agency for support. Middle Earth was nominated by Renee Schubert, Administrative Assistant.

It was determined that a substantial number of teenagers were spending a significant amount of their time on the "street," experiencing failure in the home and in school.

According to Maria Strada, Executive Director of Middle Earth, "We are so grateful for the support of businesses like Alpine Business Systems who recognize the contributions that non-profits, such as Middle Earth, make to our community. Like Alpine, Middle Earth seeks to improve the quality of life for those we serve, our community, and our staff. The program provided the opportunity to have many positive experiences from Family Nights to Field trips during the summer camp. Middle Earth truly gives back to the community by providing caring and affordable after school care. My family will always have great memories of the time there and the lasting friendships that were made."
