**FOOD MINISTRY OF THE REFORMED CHURCH OF BOUND BROOK SELECTED AS

After Hurricane Floyd they stepped up and provided not only groceries, but meals and fellowship to the people who had lost their homes and all of their possessions as a result of that horrible flood. To watch them continue 22 years later shows how important this ministry is. I am proud to have nominated them as an Alpine Hero of the Month.”
